If a candidate cannot produce appropriate identification, compliance may be achieved if they produce one of the following:

A letter from the candidate's employer typed on the firm's letterhead and signed by an official of the company. This letter must state that the employee is who they claim to be. If the candidate is not employed and is being sponsored by a government or other agency the same would apply, only the letter must be from the sponsoring agency.

Candidates have the right to refuse to disclose any identification information, however, candidates refusing or failing to provide appropriate identification will not be issued certification.
